A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT	relating to criminal procedure; to prohibit persons on
2		parole, probation, or work release from acting as
3		undercover agents or employees of law enforcement; and to
4		prohibit the admissibility of evidence derived from such
5		actions.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>A person placed on probation by a court of the</u>
2	State of Nebraska, an inmate of any jail or correctional or penal
3	facility, or an inmate who has been released on parole, probation, or
4	work release shall be prohibited from acting as an undercover agent
5	or employee of any law enforcement agency of the state or any
6	political subdivision. Any evidence derived in violation of this
7	section shall not be admissible against any person in any proceeding
8	whatsoever.
