5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 60-155, Reissue Revised Statutes of 1 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 60-155 (1) For each notation of a lien by a county, the fee shall be seven dollars. Two dollars shall be retained by the 4 5 county. Four dollars shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. One dollar 6 7 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the General 8 Fund. (2) For each notation of a lien by the department, the 9 10 fee shall be seven dollars. Four dollars shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash 11 12 Fund. Three dollars , which shall be remitted to the State Treasurer 13 for credit to the Motor Carrier Division Cash Fund. 14 Sec. 2. Section 60-156, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read: 15 16 60-156 (1) For each duplicate certificate of title issued by a county for a vehicle, the fee shall be fourteen dollars. Ten 17 dollars shall be retained by the county. Four dollars shall be 18 19 remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor 20 Vehicles Cash Fund. (2) For each duplicate certificate of title issued by the 21 22 department for a vehicle, the fee shall be fourteen dollars. Four 23 dollars shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Ten dollars , which shall be 24 25 remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Motor Carrier

1 Division Cash Fund.

Sec. 3. Original sections 60-155 and 60-156, Reissue
Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.

4 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect 5 when passed and approved according to law.
