### A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Uniform Trust Code; to amend sections 30-3823 and 30-3855, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to testamentary powers and other powers, rights, and duties; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 12 30-3855 (UTC 603) (a) While a trust is revocable, rights
- 13 of the beneficiaries are subject to the control of, and the duties of
- 14 the trustee are owed exclusively to, the settlor.
- 15 (b) <del>During While the trust is irrevocable and during the</del>
- 16 period the power may be exercised, the holder of a power of
- 17 withdrawal has the rights of a settlor of a revocable trust under
- 18 this section and the duties of the trustee are owed exclusively to
- 19 the holder of the power to the extent of the property subject to the
- 20 power.
- 21 (c) While the trust is irrevocable and during the period
- 22 the interest of any beneficiary not having a present interest may be
- 23 terminated by the exercise of a power of appointment or other power,
- 24 the duties of the trustee are owed exclusively to the holder of the
- 25 power to the extent of the property subject to the power.
