- 3 43-2,119 (1) The number of judges of the separate
- 4 juvenile court in counties which have established a separate juvenile
- 5 court shall be:
- 6 (a) Two judges in counties having seventy-five thousand
- 7 inhabitants but less than two hundred thousand inhabitants;
- 8 (b) Four judges in counties having at least two hundred
- 9 thousand inhabitants but less than four hundred thousand inhabitants;
- 10 and
- 11 (c) Five—Six judges in counties having four hundred
- 12 thousand inhabitants or more.
- 13 (2) The senior judge in point of service as a juvenile
- 14 court judge shall be the presiding judge. The judges shall rotate the
- 15 office of presiding judge every three years unless the judges agree
- 16 to another system.
