- FOR AN ACT relating to county assessment duties; to amend section
 77-1340.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
 change a provision relating to assumption of contractual
 requirements; to repeal the original section; and to
 declare an emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 77-1340.04, Reissue Revised Statutes

- 2 of Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 77-1340.04 (1) On July 1, 2013, the Property Tax
- 4 Administrator shall relinquish the property assessment function in
- 5 all counties that transferred the assessment function to the Property
- 6 Tax Administrator and have not reassumed the assessment function
- 7 prior to such date.
- 8 (2) On July 1, 2013, the employees of the Department of
- 9 Revenue involved in the performance of the county assessment function
- 10 shall become county employees by operation of law.
- 11 (3) At the close of business on June 30, 2013, the
- 12 Property Tax Administrator shall cease his or her performance of the
- 13 county assessment function and the county assessor appointed pursuant
- 14 to subsection (4) of this section shall assume the county assessment
- 15 function. The Property Tax Administrator shall at that time transfer
- 16 all books, files, and similar records with regard to the county
- 17 assessment function of the county and all furniture, computers, and
- 18 other equipment and property used by the state to perform the county
- 19 assessment function, other than motor vehicles, to the county
- assessor.
- 21 (4) In such counties, the county board shall appoint an
- 22 individual with a valid assessor's certificate to the position of
- 23 county assessor. The appointment shall be effective July 1, 2013. On
- 24 July 1, 2013, the appointed county assessor shall assume the title
- 25 and perform the assessment functions and any other duties mandated of

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1 the office of county assessor. The appointed assessor shall continue

- 2 to perform the county assessor's duties until an assessor is elected
- 3 at the next election.
- 4 (5) The Property Tax Administrator shall provide to each
- 5 county board of a county that transferred the assessment function to
- 6 the Property Tax Administrator on or before October 1, 2009, a line-
- 7 item allocation of its total cost of the assessment function for the
- 8 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. This allocation of costs shall also
- 9 identify the costs attributable to those employees that perform
- 10 duties in more than one county.
- 11 (6) <u>All contracts Contracts of the Department of Revenue</u>
- 12 pertaining to the operation of the county assessment function shall
- 13 <u>may</u> be assumed by the county. until the expiration of the contract.
- 14 (7) Counties in which there are employees of the
- 15 department who provide services to more than one county shall enter
- 16 into an agreement pursuant to section 77-1339 for the continued
- 17 performance of the services provided by the employee. No agreement
- 18 pursuant to section 77-1339 is necessary if one of the counties in
- 19 which the employee is providing services agrees to retain the
- 20 employee as a permanent full-time employee.
- 21 Sec. 2. Original section 77-1340.04, Reissue Revised
- 22 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
- Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 24 when passed and approved according to law.
