Section 1. Section 44-361.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 44-361.01 A licensed agent, whose total commissions and 4 underwriting fees on business written upon the property, life, 5 health, or liability of himself or herself, his or her relatives by б consanguinity or affinity, and his or her employer or employees 7 exceed ten thirty percent of the total commissions or underwriting 8 fees received during any one license year $_{\tau}$ shall be presumed to have obtained a license or renewal thereof primarily to circumvent the 9 enforcement of section 44-361. A licensed $agent_7$ whose commissions 10 11 and underwriting fees on such business exceed thirty fifty percent of 12 the total commissions and underwriting fees received during any one 13 license year, shall be conclusively presumed to have obtained a 14 license or renewal thereof primarily to circumvent the enforcement of section 44-361. 15
