# A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Legislature; to create the Nebraska's
- 2 Emerging Future Subcommittee of the Legislature's
- 3 Planning Committee; and to provide powers and duties.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) The Nebraska's Emerging Future

- 2 Subcommittee of the Legislature's Planning Committee is hereby
- 3 <u>created. The subcommittee shall be composed of all members of the</u>
- 4 Legislature's Planning Committee and, as ex officio members, the
- 5 chairpersons of all standing committees of the Legislature who are
- 6 not already members of the Legislature's Planning Committee.
- 7 (2) The subcommittee shall issue a report to the
- 8 Legislature prior to December 1 of each even-numbered year which may
- 9 <u>include:</u>
- 10 (a) An analysis of the current state tax structure:
- 11 (b) Any proposals for legislation to reconfigure the
- 12 state tax structure in a manner more beneficial to the citizens of
- 13 the State of Nebraska;
- 14 (c) A list of state-funded programs and services enacted
- primarily for the purpose of economic development;
- 16 (d) A cost-benefit analysis of any or all state-funded
- 17 programs or services enacted primarily for the purpose of economic
- 18 <u>development;</u>
- 19 (e) An assessment of whether any or all state-funded
- 20 programs and services enacted primarily for the purpose of economic
- 21 development are consistent with the strategic vision for advancing
- 22 Nebraska's economic development efforts as identified in A
- 23 Competitive Advantage Assessment and Strategy for Nebraska, a 2010
- 24 study prepared by Battelle Technology Partnership Practice for the
- 25 Department of Economic Development and the Department of Labor;

1	(f) Any proposals for legislation to expand, reduce, or
2	eliminate state funding for programs or services enacted primarily
3	for the purpose of economic development; and
4	(g) Any proposals for legislation to extend the sunset
5	date of any or all state-funded programs enacted primarily for the
6	purpose of economic development.
7	(3) In order to fulfill its duties, the subcommittee may:
8	(a) Hold public hearings;
9	(b) Obtain data and information from state agencies, the
10	University of Nebraska, and private entities that contract with the
11	state; and
12	(c) Contract for assistance, including consultants, with
13	the approval of the Legislature's Planning Committee and the
1 4	Everytive Roard of the Legislative Council
