A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend
2 section 60-6,161, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
3 to change provisions relating to turn signals; and to
4 repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-6,161, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 60-6,161 (1) No person shall turn a vehicle or move right
4 or left upon a roadway unless and until such movement can be made
5 with reasonable safety nor without giving an appropriate signal in
6 the manner provided in sections 60-6,162 and 60-6,163.

7 (2) A signal of intention to turn or move right or left
8 when required shall be given continuously ~~during~~ for not less than
9 the last one hundred feet traveled by the vehicle before turning or,
10 in the case of a stopped vehicle, for a reasonable time immediately
11 preceding the turn.

12 (3) No person shall stop or suddenly decrease the speed
13 of a vehicle without first giving an appropriate signal in the manner
14 provided in such sections to the driver of any vehicle immediately to
15 the rear when there is opportunity to give such signal.

16 (4) The brake and turnsignal lights required on vehicles
17 by section 60-6,226 shall not be flashed on one side only on a
18 disabled vehicle, flashed as a courtesy or do pass signal to
19 operators of other vehicles approaching from the rear, or flashed on
20 one side only of a parked vehicle except as may be necessary for
21 compliance with this section.
