- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to employment; to restrict public employer
- 2 requests for criminal history information from an
- 3 applicant for employment.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB 932

1 Section 1. (1) A public employer shall not ask an

- 2 applicant for employment to disclose, orally or in writing,
- 3 <u>information concerning the applicant's criminal record or history</u>,
- 4 including any inquiry on any employment application, until the public
- 5 employer has determined the applicant meets the minimum employment
- 6 qualifications.
- 7 (2) This section does not apply to any law enforcement
- 8 agency as defined by section 81-1401, to any position for which a
- 9 public employer is required by federal or state law to conduct a
- 10 criminal history record check, or to any position for which federal
- 11 or state law specifically disqualifies an applicant with a criminal
- 12 <u>background</u>.
- 13 (3) This section does not prevent a public employer from
- 14 conducting a criminal history record check after the public employer
- 15 <u>has determined that the applicant meets the minimum employment</u>
- 16 qualifications.
- 17 (4) For purposes of this section, public employer means
- 18 the State of Nebraska or any political or governmental subdivision of
- 19 <u>the State of Nebraska.</u>
