#### A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend section 54-857, Revised

  Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012; to provide for a

  dairy growth study and funding for the study; and to

  repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) On or before November 15, 2014, the

- 2 Director of Agriculture shall provide a report to the Legislature, in
- 3 <u>electronic format, that contains:</u>
- 4 (a) A quantitative and qualitative description of dairy
- 5 production in Nebraska, including an overview on the numbers, sizes
- 6 and ownership characteristics of dairy operations in the state,
- 7 <u>current quantity and value of milk production, trends in milk</u>
- 8 production, and measures of productivity of dairy production in
- 9 <u>Nebraska;</u>
- 10 (b) A comparison of volume and value of milk production
- 11 and trends in milk production in Nebraska to that of neighboring
- 12 <u>states and nationally;</u>
- 13 (c) A listing and description of milk processing
- 14 facilities in Nebraska and a description of marketing affiliations
- 15 and final consumer markets and destinations, including self-
- 16 processing and direct marketing, for milk produced in Nebraska;
- 17 (d) An evaluation of the potential for expanded milk
- 18 production in Nebraska with respect to (i) the ability of
- 19 agricultural, institutional, and commercial assets within the state
- 20 to support expanded production, (ii) supplying in-state processing
- 21 demand, (iii) the viability of existing processing and marketing
- 22 outlets for Nebraska milk, (iv) serving new or expanding markets
- 23 <u>outside of Nebraska, and (v) the potential for investment in new or</u>
- 24 <u>expanded dairy processing facilities;</u>
- 25 (e) A discussion of constraints to the establishment of

1 new milk production facilities, expansion of milk production, and

- 2 relocation of dairy operations into Nebraska;
- 3 (f) A review of public and private programs and
- 4 initiatives to stimulate expanded milk production in Nebraska and to
- 5 recruit milk production to relocate to Nebraska; and
- 6 (g) A compilation and overview of state incentives and
- 7 outreach and marketing programs for the recruitment or relocation of
- 8 dairy production and processing or the stimulation of investment in
- 9 new or expanded dairy production and processing for states
- 10 <u>surrounding Nebraska.</u>
- 11 (2) In the report, the Director of Agriculture may
- 12 <u>include any recommendations to the Legislature regarding actions</u>
- 13 state and local governments may take to aide and encourage expansion
- of milk production and markets for milk production in Nebraska. It is
- 15 the intent of the Legislature that the Agriculture Committee of the
- 16 Legislature shall hold a public hearing to receive the report and to
- 17 take public comment on the report and any recommendations.
- 18 Sec. 2. Section 54-857, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 19 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 20 54-857 All money received pursuant to the Commercial Feed
- 21 Act shall be remitted by the director to the State Treasurer for
- 22 credit to the Commercial Feed Administration Cash Fund which is
- 23 hereby created. Such fund shall be used by the department to aid in
- 24 defraying the expenses of administering the act, to provide resources
- 25 to prepare the Nebraska dairy industry report as provided in section

1 <u>1 of this act,</u> and to aid in defraying the expenses related to a

- 2 cooperative agreement with the United States Department of
- 3 Agriculture Market News reporting program. Transfers may be made from
- 4 the fund to the General Fund at the direction of the Legislature. Any
- 5 money in the Commercial Feed Administration Cash Fund available for
- 6 investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant
- 7 to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds
- 8 Investment Act.
