WHEREAS, Don Dolejs ran a successful Anheuser-Busch distributorship
in Fremont, Nebraska, for forty-one years; and

WHEREAS, Don Dolejs was a lifelong promoter of Fremont, Nebraska.
He was generous with his time and talents, serving key roles with the
Fremont Area Community Foundation, as well as being an active member of his
church, the Boy Scouts of America, and several service clubs; and

WHEREAS, Don Dolejs was a devoted husband and loving father to his
children, Debra, Christopher, Bradley, and Douglas, as well as their
extended families; and

WHEREAS, Don Dolejs died January 25, 2013, in Palm Desert,
California.
