### **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

## LB125

#### **Chairperson: Senator Bill Avery**

#### **Committee: Government, Military and Veterans Affairs**

#### Date of Hearing: January 24, 2013

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 125 would promote efficiency in the Boards of Education of Class V school districts by reducing their membership from 12 members to 9, with the associated districts provided with the bill.

LB 125 would further work to encourage the introduction of fresh thinking and ideas into Class V Boards of Education by establishing "legislature-style" term limits of two consecutive four year terms with allowances to run for the position again after a 4 year hiatus.

LB 125 alters the election schedule for Class V school board elections to be held in concert with the city elections of the city the school district encompasses, as well as providing provisions to allow for the immediate attachment to the 2013 election cycle.
