The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 127 provides for voter preregistration of certain youth who are 16 and 17 years of age. Allowing young people to preregister to vote will involve them in the democratic process and state and local government.

LB 127 would help to create an informed electorate and as young people who preregister may be more likely to become informed before they are old enough to vote. We have a responsibility to the young people in our state to prepare them for adulthood. Part of this preparation includes teaching young people about their rights and how to exercise those rights responsibly. In Nebraska we have already placed a value on these concepts as we allow 17 year olds to vote in primary elections if they will be 18 by the time of the general election.
