The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Current statute requires that a juvenile undergo an evaluation prior to commitment to the Office of Juvenile Services. However, if a juvenile is committed more than once, these evaluations can be redundant and wasteful of both time and money. LB 471 allows a waiver of a repeat evaluation if 1) there has been a substantially equivalent evaluation within the last twelve months that makes reevaluation unnecessary; or 2) an addendum to a previous evaluation rather than a reevaluation would be appropriate.
