The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 560 would update various labor laws to provide protections and remedies for victims of wage theft. The bill does the following:

- 1. Requires employers who fall under the Nebraska Fair Employment Practice Act to keep employment records for at least five years, or longer if required by the Nebraska Equal Opportunity Commission
- 2. Requires that employers provide employees with 30 days written notice beforealtering wages
- 3. Requires that employers furnish each employee with an itemized statement listing their wages and deductions on each payday
- 4. Provides criminal penalties for violations of the Nebraska Wage Payment and Collection Act
- 5. Provides whistleblower protections under the Wage and Hour Act, Nebraska Wage Payment and Collection Act, and Employee Misclassification Act
