Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The intent of LB 643 is to give cities of the first and second class, and villages more local control over the regulation of nuisances created by the excessive growth of weeds, grasses and worthless vegetation.

LB 643 would allow these cities and villages to determine at what height weeds and grasses become nuisances and to determine the process to notify the property owner. The bill would also clarify the procedure for property owners to appeal a nuisance citation.
