The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 706 makes it illegal to knowingly solicit or knowingly receive child pornography and makes all property involved in the offense subject to a forfeiture action by the State. Additionally, LB 706 allows out-of-state convictions to act as a penalty enhancement in child enticement and child pornography prosecutions. Finally, LB 706 criminalizes the act of knowingly causing a child to view a live sex act by specifically classifying it as child abuse.
