The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 740 grants residency for the purposes of in-state tuition for recently separated veterans, their spouses and dependents. Specifically, veterans who separated from a branch of the Armed Forces of the United States within the past two years are considered resident students, provided the veteran demonstrates intent to become a resident of the state of Nebraska. Intent to become a resident consists of voter registration as well as a Nebraska motor vehicle registration or Nebraska driver's license.
