Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The purpose of LB753 is to amend the Nebraska Uniform Limited Liability Company Act to provide a mechanism for an agent for service of process for a domestic or foreign limited liability company to change its street and mailing address and post office number for any domestic or foreign limited liability company for which the agent is designated.

To change its address, the agent must notify the domestic or foreign limited liabilty company of the change of address and deliver to the Secretary of State for filing a statement of change of address for an agent for service of process.

Similar language was included in the prior laws related to limited liability companies, but was not included in the Nebraska Uniform Limited Liability Company Act, which was enacted in 2010. Under Nebraska statutes, agents for corporations and nonprofit corporations are allowed to change their address by delivering a document to the Secretary of State for filing. This bill would reconcile the Nebraska Uniform Limited Liability Company Act with the other business entity acts by allowing an agent to change its address by delivering the appropriate document to the Secretary of State for filing
