The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 802 eliminates language that allowed cities of the first class, second class, and villages to adopt certain standard codes and their amendments by reference. The bill also eliminates this same language that had authorized adoption by reference for certain codes by a county board. The Nebraska Supreme Court has declared that adoption of codes by reference is an unconstitutional delegation of legislative authority, and this bill is part of a continuing effort to remove this language from the code adoption statutes.
