The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 803 clarifies a mayor's veto authority in cities of the first and second classes. Current law allows mayors in cities of the first and second classes to veto ordinances, but the procedure to do so is unclear and contradictory. LB 803 establishes a clear procedure for a veto similar to the Governor's veto authority, and makes the veto authority the same in both classes of city.
