The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 939 creates the offense of false presentation. If a person furnishes proof of financial responsibility he or she knows to be false or misleading to any peace officer or other official, with the intent to impede a criminal investigation, or to acquire a motor vehicle registration, commits the offense of false presentation.

LB 939 designates such an offense as a Class I misdemeanor. It also requires that upon conviction, the DMV will suspend vehicle registrations of the person, unless the person maintains for three (3) years, proof of financial responsibility.
