1. On page 2, lines 19 through 26, strike the new matter and 1 reinstate the stricken matter; and after line 30 insert the following new 2 3 subsection: "(4)(a) On and after July 1, 2016, every public and private school 4 5 shall provide each student entering the seventh grade and each student 6 entering the junior year of high school and the student's parent or legal 7 guardian with information about meningococcal disease and its vaccine. Such information shall include: 8 (i) The causes and symptoms of meningococcal disease, how the 9 disease is spread, and the places where parents and quardians may obtain 10 additional information; and 11 (ii) Current recommendations from the United States Centers for 12 13 Disease Control and Prevention regarding the receipt of vaccines for meningococcal disease and where the vaccination may be received. 14 15 (b) This subsection shall not be construed to require the Department of Health and Human Services or any public or private school to provide 16 meningococcal vaccination to students. 17 (c) The Department of Health and Human Services shall prepare the 18 informational materials required in this subsection. 19

20 (d) This subsection does not create a private right of action.".
