LB 128 (*Chambers*) Repeal the Black-Tailed Prairie Dog Management Act

- LB 439 (*Morfeld*) Change Nebraska Liquor Control Act penalty provisions for certain violations
- LB 242e (*Stinner*) Change provisions of the Dry Bean Resources Act
- LB 242Ae (*Stinner*) Appropriation Bill
- LB 367 (*Groene*) Eliminate a restriction on paying petition circulators based on number of signatures

- \* LB 324 (*McCullister*) Provide additional powers for sanitary and improvement districts, require acknowledgments from purchasers of real estate within sanitary and improvement districts, and prohibit expenditures pending annexation
- LB 356 (*Harr*) Change provisions relating to the assessment of certain rent-restricted housing projects
- \* LB 627 (*Mello*) Change provisions relating to pregnancy and eliminate subversive membership provisions under the Nebraska Fair Employment Practice Act
