Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill directs the Department of Health and Human Services to develop a plan to ensure compliance with U.S. Supreme Court's decision in Olmstead v. L.C. and to create a stakeholder advisory committee to help guide the development of a strategic plan to address serving individuals with developmental disabilities in community-based settings. The bill requires DHHS's strategic plan to be completed by December 15, 2018.

Explanation of amendments:

AM2048 corrects "placing" language as requested by the Department of Health and Human Services. Adds members to the advisory committee, from vocational rehab at the Dept. of Education, and two persons with disabilities.
