Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Suspending medicaid for inmates is a policy recommendation related to corrections and access to/continuity of care being discussed nationwide. Federal matching dollars are prohibited for inmates.

Section-by-section description:

Section 1: Legislative intent to ensure DHHS and Corrections recognize that while Federal matching dollars are not allowed for inmates, it is available after release and DHHS can process Medicaid applications for inmates. Suspends, rather than terminates Medicaid for inmates who were enrolled in Medicaid prior to incarceration, are otherwise eligible, and for whom the Department is notified of the incarceration. The suspension ends when the inmate is released or after one year.

AM293 strikes the one year limitation on the suspension of Medicaid for inmates
