Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 133 amends section 48-125 pertaining to late payments and penalties for workers' compensation benefits. LB 133 would change the interest rate calculation from the 14% interest employed in section 45-104.01 to the rate calculation provided in section 45-103. The judgment rate in section 45-103 is equal to 2 percentage points above the bond investment yield, as published by the U.S. Secretary of Treasury. As of January 16, 2015, the judgment interest rate is 2.132%.
