## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 205 requires any tower located outside the boundaries of a city or village on rural or undeveloped property shall be marked, painted, or otherwise constructed to be visible in clear air during daylight hours from a distance of at least 2,000 feet.

The bill states that all towers will also:

- Be painted in alternating band of aviation orange and white;
- Have one marker ball attached to the top one-third of each outside guide wire;
- Have a seven-foot long safety sleeve on certain guide wires.

Any tower erected prior to the enacting of this bill will have one year to come into compliance with this act.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

The committee amended LB 205 to limit the bill to meteorological evaluation towers only.
