Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The legislation is the annual federal regulation update for several provisions of law administered by the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles and the Nebraska State Patrol. In each of these sections the Legislature has incorporated by reference specific federal regulations or law as provisions of Nebraska law. To update any revisions made to these regulations by the federal government the Legislature must act affirmatively to adopt any such changes by the enactment of legislation. Regulations adopted by reference and incorporated into Nebraska law are those regulations in existence as of January 1, 2015.

Section 60-336.01- definition of low-speed vehicle.

Section 60-3,113.04-design requirements for handicapped or disabled parking permits.

Section 60- 3,193.01- adoption of the International Registration Plan (commercial vehicles operated in interstate commerce).

Section 60-479.01- operator's license issuance, verification of lawful status.

Section 60-4,147.02- commercial driver's license, hazardous materials endorsement, compliance with USA PATRIOT Act

Section 75-363-adoption of federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations

Section 75-364-adoption of federal Hazardous Material Regulations.

Section 75-366- technical reference to the federal Motor carrier Safety Regulations and the federal Hazardous Material

Safety Regulations. Section 75-393- adoption of the federal Unified Carrier Registration Act of 2005.
