The purpose of Legislative Bill 361 is to clarify the language in the statutes that permit natural resource districts, sanitary drainage districts, sanitary and improvement districts, special improvement districts, counties, cities of all classes, and villages to levy special assessments for improvements made by the political subdivision that benefit individual properties. The bill amends statutes relating to the collection of assessment and fees to clarify the collections are "special assessments".
