## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The Community-Based Energy Development Act (C-BED) was created in 2007. It created the program to promote community-based renewable energy projects that were to provide local and regional economic development benefits while ensuring that local citizens could jointly invest in a project as developers and keep the financial benefits of ownership in the local community. LB 412 makes changes to the C-BED law so that it may be more easily used.

First, the bill requires a resolution of support to be adopted for a C-BED project from the local county board only if such board has adopted zoning regulations that require a planning commission, county board, or county commission approval for the project. Second, the bill removes the requirement that a C-BED project developer offer an ownership opportunity to property owners, and replaces it with a requirement that notice of incentives under the program are to be provided to each property owner on whose property a turbine would be placed and to the elected governing body of the same location.
