Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 481 would allow school districts that would otherwise be required to be in a learning community to opt out.

Section 32-546.01 would be amended by declaring a vacancy in office for appointed members of learning community coordinating councils when the school district served by an appointed member opts out of the learning community.

Section 79-2102 would be amended to all school districts which would otherwise be required to be in a learning community to opt out with a majority vote of the members of the school board and by providing written notification from the board to the learning community coordinating council and to the Commissioner of Education at least 6 months before the effective date.
