Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends section 60-484.04; identification required to obtain issuance of a Nebraska operator's license or state identification card.

Self

The section is amended to provide it is the intent of the Legislature that an individual may demonstrate lawful status in the United States for the purpose of showing eligibility to obtain a federally secure Nebraska motor vehicle operator's license or state identification card by demonstrating that they have lawful status in this country as enumerated in section 202(c)(2)(B)(i) through (ix) of the federal Real ID Act of 2005, Public Law 109-13.

The bill has the emergency clause.

Explanation of amendments:

The Committee considered and adopted an amendment which adds section 60-484.05; issuance of temporary operator's licenses and state identification cards to the bill.

A new subsection (4) is added to the section which provides that an individual who has an operator's license or state identification card issue based on approved lawful status under section 202(c)(2)(B)(i) through (ix) of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005 and the basis for the approved lawful status is terminated, the individual shall return the operator's license or state identification card to the Department of Motor Vehicles.
