### Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The legislation amends the following provisions of law:

Section 37-1214- registration of motorboats

Section 37-1278-certificates of title for motorboats

Section 60-144- certificates of title for motor vehicles and trailers

Section 60-386-registration of motor vehicles and trailers

Each section is amended to provide that on or before January 1, 2020 the director of motor vehicles shall modify the application forms prescribed by each section above to require that, in addition to any other information required to be supplied, an applicant shall provide their full legal name, their motor vehicle operator's license, state identification card, or tax identification number. Additionally, the applicant shall provide one other form of identification from the list prescribed by section 60-484.

Also, section 60-386 is amended to provide that in addition to currently prescribed vehicle identification information required for vehicle registration the applicant shall include the United States Department of Transportation number.

# **Explanation of amendments:**

The Committee considered and adopted an amendment which accomplishes the following:

The amendment revises the new information requirement proposed by the bill to provide when the owner of a motorboat or vehicle is a business entity, a nonprofit organization, an estate, trust, or church-controlled organization in lieu of personal identification elements required by the bill, such entity shall provide its tax identification number.
