Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill, introduced at the request of the Director of Banking and Finance, would amend provisions relating to powers of state-chartered financial institutions.

The bill would amend section 8-1,140 of the Nebraska Banking Act, section 8-355 of the state-chartered savings and loan association statutes, and section 21-17,115 of the Nebraska Credit Union Act to provide that state-chartered banks, savings and loan associations, and credit unions shall have all the rights, powers, privileges, benefits, and immunities which may be exercised by their federal counter parts as of January 1, 2016 rather than January 1, 2015.

Due to state constitutional restrictions on delegation of legislative authority, these sections are amended annually.

The bill carries the emergency clause.
