Current law allows an appeal but does not specify the appeal procedures. The notice and appeal procedures for obstruction-related nuisances under LB 703 mirror the current notice and appeal procedures for weeds and litter-related nuisances in cities of the first class, cities of the second class, and villages. **Explanation of amendments:** AM 1877 clarifies that if no appeal is filed, the city or village may abate the nuisance.
