## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB899 was brought at the request of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to update Nebraska law to conform with the federal definition of lead free in the federal Safe Drinking Water Act, effective January 2014. Nebraska is required to have laws as stringent as the federal laws for compliance purposes. Strikes specific requirements for public water systems. Permits DHHS to adopt and promulgate rules and regulations regarding the use of lead-free materials in public water systems.
