Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends section 60-3,122, issuance of Pearl Harbor Survivor license plates and section 60-3,124, issuance of disabled veteran license plates.

Currently each section provides that when the Pearl Harbor Survivor or disabled veteran license plates are issued there is to be charged, in addition to all other fees, a fee of \$5 which is credited to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operating Fund. Both sections are amended by striking the collection of the \$5 fee.
