Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LR455 creates a special committee to examine issues related to the impacts of climate change on the State of

Nebraska, including assessments of vulnerability, risks, and economic impacts. The committee will also examine opportunities, including methods of producing food, generating power, or protecting land and water that can be used to adapt and mitigate the impacts of climate change and that will provide jobs and economic benefits to Nebraskans.

The committee would consist of:

The chairperson of the Agriculture Committee of the Legislature or his or her designee;

The chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of the Legislature or his or her designee;

The chairperson of the Health and Human Services Committee of the Legislature or his or her designee;

The chairperson of the Education Committee of the Legislature or his or her designee;

The chairperson of the Natural Resources Committee of the Legislature or his or her designee; and

Two at-large members of the Legislature appointed by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council.

The committee members select a chairperson and vice-chairperson from the membership of the committee.

The committee is tasked with several duties, including establishing a framework for a plan for the State of Nebraska related to the impacts of climate change on the state. This plan, together with the committee%u2019s findings and recommendations, are to be submitted to the Legislature on or before December 31, 2016.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment changes the membership of the special committee to include the chairperson of the Appropriations Committee or his or her designee, the chairperson of the Natural Resources Committee or his or her designee, and five at-large members of the Legislature to be appointed by the Executive Board.
