LB 131 provides that whenever a sanitary and improvement district (SID) receives notice that a city or village is proposing to annex their district or a portion thereof, they are prohibited from spending assets that were used to determine the feasibility of the annexation until the annexation is approved by the city or village.

No immediate fiscal impact. This prohibition on the SID spending assets will only come into play when an annexation notice is received. At that time there may be an impact on SID expenditures.
