- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to economic development; to amend section 13-208, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to adopt the Next Generation Business Growth Act; to state intent regarding funding; to change funding for tax credits under the Community Development Assistance Act; to provide a termination date; and to
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 6 of this act shall be known and may be
- 2 <u>cited as the Next Generation Business Growth Act.</u>
- 3 Sec. 2. The Legislature finds that there is an important role that
- 4 innovation and entrepreneurship play in the economic well-being of the
- 5 state. It is the intent of the Legislature to promote such innovation and
- 6 <u>entrepreneurship through the Next Generation Business Growth Act.</u>
- 7 Sec. 3. (1) The Legislature's Venture Development and Innovation
- 8 Task Force is created. The Executive Board of the Legislative Council
- 9 shall appoint six members of the Legislature to the task force. The
- 10 Executive Board shall appoint one of the six members as chairperson and
- 11 another member as vice-chairperson.
- 12 <u>(2) The task force shall develop a statewide strategic plan to</u>
- 13 cultivate a climate of entrepreneurship and innovation. The task force
- 14 shall adopt policy criteria to be used in the development of the plan.
- 15 The plan shall include: (a) An inventory of existing state-sponsored and
- 16 locally sponsored programs and resources that are targeted to small
- 17 <u>businesses, microenterprises, and entrepreneurial endeavors in the state;</u>
- 18 (b) an economic impact analysis of the existing programs under the
- 19 Business Innovation Act; (c) an overview of best practices from other
- 20 <u>states; (d) a review of previously issued statewide strategic plans</u>
- 21 focused on high-growth businesses; and (e) various policy options.
- 22 (3) On or before December 1, 2016, the Legislature's Venture
- 23 Development and Innovation Task Force shall prepare and electronically
- 24 <u>submit the statewide strategic plan to the Clerk of the Legislature.</u>
- 25 Sec. 4. The Legislature's Venture Development and Innovation Task
- 26 Force, in consultation with the Executive Board of the Legislative
- 27 <u>Council, shall employ a nonprofit organization to provide research,</u>
- 28 <u>analysis</u>, and recommendations for the development of the statewide
- 29 <u>strategic plan required by section 3 of this act.</u>
- 30 Sec. 5. It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate seventy-
- 31 five thousand dollars from the General Fund to the Legislative Council

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- 1 <u>for carrying out the purposes of the Next Generation Business Growth Act.</u>
- 2 Sec. 6. The Next Generation Business Growth Act terminates on
- 3 January 1, 2017.
- 4 Sec. 7. Section 13-208, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 5 2014, is amended to read:
- 6 13-208 The total amount of tax credit granted for programs approved
- 7 and certified under the Community Development Assistance Act by the
- 8 department for any fiscal year shall not exceed three hundred fifty
- 9 thousand dollars, except that for fiscal year 2016-17 2014-15, the total
- 10 amount of tax credit granted under this section shall be reduced by
- 11 <u>seventy-five</u> fifty thousand dollars.
