- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section
- 2 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015; to prohibit flying
- 3 lanterns; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the original section;
- 4 and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, is
2 amended to read:

3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-468, 28-470 to 28-1357, 28-1418.01, and
4 28-1429.03 and section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as
5 the Nebraska Criminal Code.

6 Sec. 2. (1) Flying lantern-type devices are prohibited from sale,
7 possession, and use in this state.

8 (2) For purposes of this section, flying lantern-type devices means
9 devices that require a flame which produces heated air trapped in a
10 balloon-type covering allowing the device to float in the air. Flying
11 lantern-type devices shall not include hot-air balloons used for
12 transporting persons.

13 (3) A violation of this section is a Class V misdemeanor.

14 Sec. 3. Original section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015,
15 is repealed.

16 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
17 passed and approved according to law.
