- 4 obtaining a chemigation permit shall be (1) subject to a civil penalty of
- 5 not more than one thousand dollars for each day at each site where a
- 6 <u>violation occurs for the first violation and not less than one thousand</u>
- 7 dollars and not more than five thousand dollars for each day at each site
- 8 where a violation occurs for each subsequent violation or (2) guilty of a
- 9 Class II misdemeanor. Each day of continued violation shall constitute a
- 10 separate offense. The court may issue such injunctive orders as may be
- 11 necessary to prohibit continued violations of the Nebraska Chemigation
- 12 Act. When the Attorney General, a county attorney, or a private attorney
- brings an action on behalf of a district to recover a civil penalty under

- 23 where a violation occurs for each subsequent violation or (2) quilty of a
- 24 Class II misdemeanor. Each day of continued violation shall constitute a
- 25 separate offense. The court may issue such injunctive orders as may be
- 26 necessary to prohibit continued violations of the Nebraska Chemigation

Each day of continued violation shall constitute a separate 10 offense. The court may issue such injunctive orders as may be necessary to prohibit continued violations of the Nebraska Chemigation Act. When 11 the Attorney General, a county attorney, or a private attorney brings an 12 action on behalf of a district to recover a civil penalty under this 13 14 section, the district shall recover the costs of the action if a civil 15 penalty is awarded. 46-1142 Any permitholder who fails to notify the district and the 18 19 department of any actual or suspected accident resulting from the use of chemigation shall be (1) subject to a civil penalty of one thousand 20 dollars for each day at each site where a violation occurs for the first 21 violation and not less than one thousand dollars and not more than five 22 thousand dollars for each day at each site where a violation occurs for 23 24 each subsequent violation not more than five hundred dollars or (2) guilty of a Class III misdemeanor. Each day of continued violation shall 25 constitute a separate offense. The court may issue such injunctive orders 26 as may be necessary to prohibit continued violations of the Nebraska 27 28 Chemigation Act. When the Attorney General, a county attorney, or a 29 private attorney brings an action on behalf of a district to recover a civil penalty under this section, the district shall recover the costs of 30 the action if a civil penalty is awarded. 31

- 5 shall be (1) subject to a civil penalty of <u>one thousand dollars for each</u>
- 6 day at each site where a violation occurs for the first violation and not
- 7 less than one thousand dollars and not more than five thousand dollars
- 8 for each day at each site where a violation occurs for each subsequent
- 9 <u>violation</u> not more than five hundred dollars or (2) guilty of a Class IV
- 10 misdemeanor. Each day of continued violation shall constitute a separate
- offense. The court may issue such injunctive orders as may be necessary
- 12 to prohibit continued violations of the Nebraska Chemigation Act. When
- 13 the Attorney General, a county attorney, or a private attorney brings an
- 14 <u>action on behalf of a district to recover a civil penalty under this</u>
- 15 section, the district shall recover the costs of the action if a civil
- 16 penalty is awarded.
