- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to environmental protection; to amend sections 1 25-21,255 and 81-1577.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to 2 3 change provisions relating to the regulation of aboveground motor vehicle fuel storage tanks; to remove an obsolete provision; to eliminate certain provisions relating to the storage of hazardous 5 6 substances; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the original 7 sections; and to outright repeal sections 81-1575, 81-1576, and 8 81-1577, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
- 9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 25-21,255, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

- 3 25-21,255 For the purposes of sections 25-21,254 to 25-21,264:
- 4 (1) Environmental audit means any document dated and labeled as a
- 5 confidential environmental audit and prepared pursuant to a specific
- 6 written directive to review compliance with an environmental requirement
- 7 or requirements, including any report, finding, communication, or opinion
- 8 or any draft of a report, finding, communication, or opinion, related to
- 9 and prepared as a result of a voluntary self-evaluation that is done in
- 10 good faith;
- 11 (2) Environmental requirement means an environmental protection
- 12 requirement contained in (a) the Environmental Protection Act, the
- 13 Integrated Solid Waste Management Act, the Nebraska Chemigation Act, the
- 14 Pesticide Act, the Petroleum Products and Hazardous Substances Storage
- 15 and Handling Act, sections 81-1575 to 81-1577, or federal law, a rule or
- 16 regulation adopted and promulgated pursuant to such acts, sections, or
- 17 laws, a permit or order issued pursuant to such acts, sections, or laws,
- 18 or an agreement entered into or court order issued pursuant to any of the
- 19 foregoing or (b) an ordinance or other legally binding requirement of a
- 20 local governmental unit under authority granted by state or federal law
- 21 relating to environmental protection;
- 22 (3) Person means any individual, partnership, limited liability
- 23 company, association, public or private corporation, trustee, receiver,
- 24 assignee, agent, municipality, other governmental subdivision, public
- 25 agency, other legal entity, or any officer or governing or managing body
- 26 of any public or private corporation, municipality, governmental
- 27 subdivision, public agency, or other legal entity; and
- 28 (4) Voluntary self-evaluation means a self-initiated assessment,
- 29 audit, or review, not otherwise expressly required by environmental
- 30 requirements, that is performed by any person for himself, herself, or
- 31 itself, either by an employee of such person assigned the responsibility

- 1 of performing such assessment, audit, or review or by a consultant
- 2 engaged by such person specifically for the purpose of performing such
- 3 assessment, audit, or review to determine whether such person is in
- 4 compliance with environmental requirements.
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 81-1577.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 6 amended to read:
- 7 81-1577.01 (1) The State Fire Marshal shall allow a tank used for
- 8 the storage of motor vehicle fuel to remain aboveground if the tank was
- 9 in existence on May 29, 1959, and is in compliance with the rules and
- 10 regulations established pursuant to section 81-502.
- 11  $(\underline{1} \ 2)$  The State Fire Marshal shall permit by rule and regulation, in
- 12 cities with a population of less than two thousand inhabitants, in
- 13 villages, and in unincorporated areas, the installation of aboveground
- 14 tanks to replace underground tanks used for the storage of motor vehicle
- 15 fuel by dealers who sell motor vehicle fuel at retail. The capacity of
- 16 the aboveground replacement tanks shall not exceed the total capacity of
- 17 the underground tanks being replaced or eighteen thousand gallons per
- 18 retail facility, whichever is less.
- 19  $(\underline{2} \ 3)$  For purposes of this section, dealers and motor vehicle fuel
- 20 shall have the meanings provided in section 66-482 for importers and
- 21 motor vehicle fuel.

- 23 Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
- 24 Sec. 4. The following sections are outright repealed: Sections
- 25 81-1575, 81-1576, and 81-1577, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
