- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to fees; to amend section 33-110, Reissue
- 2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to increase fees for marriage licenses
- as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 33-110, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

2 amended to read:

33-110 County clerks shall receive no fee for the performance of the 3 following services: For issuing certificates of election; for performing 4 the duties of clerk of the county board; for taking acknowledgments of 5 claims against the county; for attesting or certifying any document 6 authorized by the county board or required by the departments of the 7 state; or for recording Army or Navy discharges or furnishing certified 8 9 copies thereof to be used in connection with any claim for compensation or disability. A charge of twenty-five cents shall be made for any other 10 certificate and seal unless otherwise provided. The fees collected shall 11 be credited to the county general fund. 12

13 County clerks shall receive a fee of <u>twenty-five</u> <u>fifteen</u> dollars for 14 the entire proceedings of issuing a marriage license, administering the 15 related oaths or affirmations, and recording a marriage certificate. An 16 additional fee of <u>nine</u> <u>five</u> dollars shall be made for each certified copy 17 of a marriage record on file in the office of the county clerk. Both such 18 fees shall be deposited in the county general fund.
