- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend sections
- 2 28-1419 and 28-1427, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014;
- 3 to change provisions relating to enforcement of certain tobacco
- 4 restriction provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 28-1419, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2014, is amended to read:
- 3 28-1419 (1) Whoever shall sell, give, or furnish, in any way, any
- 4 tobacco in any form whatever, or any cigars, cigarettes, cigarette paper,
- 5 vapor products, or alternative nicotine products, to any minor under
- 6 eighteen years of age, is guilty of a Class III misdemeanor for each
- 7 offense.
- 8 (2)(a) In order to further the public policy of deterring licensees
- 9 or other persons from violating subsection (1) of this section, persons
- 10 at least fourteen years of age but under eighteen years of age may be
- 11 authorized to assist peace officers or private contractors hired as part
- of a licensee-organized, self-compliance check in determining compliance
- 13 with such subsection. Persons under eighteen years of age may be so
- 14 <u>authorized if:</u>
- (i) The person is an employee, a volunteer, or an intern with:
- 16 (A) A state or local law enforcement agency;
- 17 <u>(B) The Department of Health and Human Services or a tobacco</u>
- 18 prevention coalition that receives grant funding under section 71-5714;
- 19 <u>(C) The United States Food and Drug Administration; or</u>
- 20 (D) A licensee;
- 21 (ii) The person is acting within the scope of his or her assigned
- 22 duties as part of an authorized law enforcement investigation, a
- 23 compliance check under subdivision (2)(b) of this section, or a licensee-
- 24 <u>organized self-compliance check; and</u>
- (iii) The person does not use or consume a tobacco product.
- 26 (b)(i) This subdivision applies only to compliance checks conducted
- 27 <u>by a private contractor for the purpose of conducting licensee education</u>
- 28 or assessing compliance with federal or state law. Compliance checks
- 29 <u>shall be conducted, at a minimum, as follows:</u>
- 30 (A) Compliance checks shall only be conducted in consultation with
- 31 the law enforcement agency providing primary police services to the

- 1 political subdivision in which the compliance check is being conducted;
- 2 (B) No person under eighteen years of age shall be authorized to
- 3 participate or assist peace officers in such compliance checks without
- 4 the written consent of his or her parents or legal guardian; and
- 5 (C) A licensee that does not violate subsection (1) of this section
- 6 during a compliance check shall be notified in writing of the compliance
- 7 check and the outcome of the compliance check.
- 8 (ii) A private contractor shall conduct a compliance check under
- 9 this subdivision no more than once every thirty days at any one licensee
- 10 location. This subdivision shall not preclude any law enforcement agency
- 11 <u>from otherwise enforcing subsection (1) of this section.</u>
- 12 <u>(c) Any person under the age of eighteen years acting in accordance</u>
- 13 with and under the authority of this subsection shall not be in violation
- 14 <u>of section 28-1427.</u>

- 17 28-1427 Except as provided in subsection (2) of section 28-1419,
- 18 any Any person under the age of eighteen years who shall obtain cigars,
- 19 tobacco, cigarettes, cigarette material, vapor products, or alternative
- 20 nicotine products from a licensee by representing that he or she is of
- 21 the age of eighteen years or over is guilty of a Class V misdemeanor.
