- 1 Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:
- 2 (a) Social security number means a nine-digit number under section
- 3 205(c)(2) of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 405(c)(2), issued by the
- 4 United States Social Security Administration;
- 5 (b) Social security number includes any number derived from the
- 6 issued number; and
- 7 (c) Social security number does not include any number that has been
- 8 <u>encrypted.</u>
- 9 (2) No person as defined in section 49-801 shall require an
- 10 <u>individual to disclose or furnish his or her social security number for</u>
- 11 any purpose in connection with any activity or refuse any service,
- 12 <u>privilege</u>, <u>or right to an individual because he or she refuses to</u>
- 13 <u>disclose or furnish his or her social security number unless (a) the</u>
- 14 individual consents to provide or allow the use of his or her social
- 15 security number, (b) the social security number is expressly required by
- 16 federal, state, or local law, rule, regulation, or ordinance, or (c) the
- 17 social security number is used for a criminal history background check of
- 18 the individual by an employer or volunteer service organization.
