**LEGISLATIVE BILL 158**

Introduced by McCollister, 20.

Committee: Business and Labor

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act; to
- 2 amend section 48-1,110, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 3 2014; to deny compensation in situations of false representation; to
- 4 harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. No compensation shall be allowed if, at the time of or  
2 in the course of entering into employment or at the time of receiving  
3 notice of the removal of conditions from a conditional offer of  
4 employment: (1) The employee knowingly and willfully made a false  
5 representation as to his or her physical or medical condition; (2) the  
6 employer relied upon the false representation and the reliance was a  
7 substantial factor in the hiring; and (3) a causal connection existed  
8 between the false representation and the injury.

9           Sec. 2. Section 48-1,110, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,  
10 2014, is amended to read:

11           48-1,110 Sections 48-101 to 48-1,117 and section 1 of this act shall  
12 be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act.

13           Sec. 3. Original section 48-1,110, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
14 Supplement, 2014, is repealed.
