- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend
- 2 section 60-6,230, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
- 3 rotating or flashing light provisions; and to repeal the original

- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 60-6,230, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 60-6,230 (1) Except as provided in sections 60-6,231 to 60-6,233 and
- 4 subsections (4) and (5) of this section, no person shall operate any
- 5 motor vehicle or any equipment of any description on any highway in this
- 6 state with any rotating or flashing light.
- 7 (2) Except for stop lights and directional signals, which may be
- 8 red, yellow, or amber, no person shall display any color of light other
- 9 than red on the rear of any motor vehicle or any equipment of any kind on
- 10 any highway within this state.
- 11 (3) Amber rotating or flashing lights shall be displayed on vehicles
- 12 of the Military Department for purpose of convoy control when on any
- 13 state emergency mission.
- 14 (4) A single flashing white light may be displayed on the roof of
- 15 school transportation vehicles during extremely adverse weather
- 16 conditions.
- 17 (5) Blue and amber rotating or flashing lights may be displayed on
- 18 (a) vehicles used for the movement of snow when operated by the
- 19 Department of Roads or any local authority or (b) vehicles operated by
- 20 any public utility for the construction, maintenance, and repair of
- 21 <u>utility infrastructure on or near any highway</u>.
