Committee: Education

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to education; to state findings; to create the
- 2 School Funding and Educational Outcomes Review Committee; and to
- 3 provide powers and duties.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB182 2015

- 1 Section 1. The Legislature finds that, because of the necessarily
- 2 complicated funding mechanisms for public schools, a committee is needed
- 3 <u>to offer perspectives on the adequacy and effectiveness of school</u>
- 4 funding.
- 5 Sec. 2. <u>The School Funding and Educational Outcomes Review</u>
- 6 Committee is created. The committee shall consist of the following
- 7 members:
- 8 <u>(1) Four members of the general public, at least one of whom has</u>
- 9 experience in the teaching profession in the public schools and no more
- 10 than two of whom shall be residents of the same congressional district;
- 11 (2) Four members who are either school superintendents or school
- 12 <u>district business officials, not more than two of whom are residents of</u>
- 13 the same congressional district;
- 14 (3) One member from a school board from each class of school
- 15 district; and
- 16 (4) The Governor or his or her designee, the Property Tax
- 17 Administrator, and the chairperson of the Education Committee of the
- 18 <u>Legislature</u>, all of whom shall be nonvoting members.
- 19 Sec. 3. <u>The chairperson of the Education Committee of the</u>
- 20 Legislature shall be the chairperson of the School Funding and
- 21 Educational Outcomes Review Committee. The School Funding and Educational
- 22 Outcomes Review Committee shall meet at least twice annually and may meet
- 23 more often upon the call of the chairperson.
- 24 Sec. 4. To assure that every Nebraskan is educated for success, the
- 25 School Funding and Educational Outcomes Review Committee shall:
- 26 (1) Review the mission of providing Nebraskans the opportunity to
- 27 acquire the necessary skills and knowledge to be productive individuals;
- 28 (2) Review, make recommendations, and report on the progress of the
- 29 goals established by the Legislature and the State Department of
- 30 Education. The committee may solicit comments, concerns, and case studies
- 31 from all sizes of schools in Nebraska and develop best practices for

- 1 implementing and achieving these goals; and
- 2 (3) Review the implementation of the Tax Equity and Educational
- 3 Opportunities Support Act and operation of budget growth limitations,
- 4 equalization aid pursuant to section 79-1008.01, the minimum levy
- 5 <u>adjustments pursuant to section 79-1008.02</u>, and expenditures of school
- 6 districts pursuant to the act.
- 7 Sec. 5. On or before July 1 of each even-numbered year, the School
- 8 Funding and Educational Outcomes Review Committee shall report to the
- 9 Governor, to the State Board of Education, and electronically to the
- 10 Legislature on the adequacy of school funding sources in effectuating
- 11 property tax relief, broadening the tax base for the support of the
- 12 public school system, equalization of the tax burden for the support of
- 13 the public school system, and equalization of educational opportunities
- 14 for students and the effects of budget limitations on district spending
- 15 patterns. The State Department of Education and the staff of the
- 16 Education Committee of the Legislature shall assist as needed and
- 17 requested by the chairperson of the committee.
